Essential Duties and Responsibilities *Other duties may be assigned.*

- Assist students in academic coursework at a site during class or in tutorial centers.
- Provide individual and group instruction.
- Provide peer mentorship and advising to assist students with goal setting as well as college preparation and planning.
- Document daily contacts with students and submit paperwork monthly (includes program applications, daily activity sheets, sign-in sheets, timecards, evaluations, etc. for State Report).
- Attend monthly meeting on Friday afternoons from 3:00-4:30pm.
- Communicate continuously with Cal-SOAP Program Manager, Cal-SOAP Tutor Coordinator and teachers via e-mail, phone, and meetings.
- Review students' progress as determined by completion of homework, test results, and other work assigned to students.
- Access school resources to further students' academic achievement and the goals of Cal-SOAP (i.e. counselors, teachers, career centers).
- Adhere to all Cal-SOAP rules and policies.

Requirements:

- Must be currently enrolled at a local college/university with undergraduate or graduate status.
- Must demonstrate financial need as determined by the financial aid office of their respective educational institution.
- Must have minimum **college cumulative** 2.5 GPA.
- Interest in working with college bound junior/middle and high school students who first-generation.
- Working knowledge of word processing, spreadsheets, internet software and must have access to a computer to regularly use the Internet, E-mail, Microsoft Excel and Word.

- Unofficial Transcript(s)
- Current Financial Aide Award Letter
- Current/Tentative Class Schedule
