College Readiness Calendar for 11th Grade Students

Fall | Eleventh Grade

- Explore ways to pay for college, starting with www.calgrants.org, www.csac.ca.gov,
- www.federalstudentaid.ed.gov and www.going2college.org.
- Sign up to take PSAT in October.
- Make a list of colleges you are considering.
- Learn the entrance requirements for the schools on your list.
- Review your class schedule with your counselor to make sure you're on track with your goals.
- Check out colleges or technical and career programs at www.californiacolleges.edu and www.nces.ed.gov/collegenavigator. Start a college folder with the information you collect.

Winter | Eleventh Grade

- Look for your PSAT results to arrive in December.
- Sign up now to take the SAT or ACT in the spring.
- Apply for Cal-SOAP's **free** SAT Prep. Course (December)
- If accepted, attend Cal-SOAP's **free** SAT Prep. Course (February).
- With your family, make an appointment with your counselor. Ask about fee waivers for the SAT.
- Attend your high school's financial aid night. It's not too early to learn about your options.

Notes:

Spring | Eleventh Grade

- Review your senior year schedule with your counselor.
- Develop a list of 10-15 colleges that interest you.
- Take the SAT, ACT, or other college entrance exam.
- Prepare early for AP Exams.
- Apply on time for summer jobs or volunteer work.

Notes:

Summer| Eleventh Grade

- Register with the NCAA Eligibility Center if you are an athlete planning to continue playing a sport in college.
- Get your FSA ID
- Make a draft of your personal statement if required.
- Register now for ACT, SAT Reasoning or SAT Subject Tests in the fall (if you want a better score or missed it this year).
- Look into programs that let you earn money for college for volunteer service, including AmeriCorps (www.americorps.gov), California Volunteers (www.californiavolunteers.org) and the California Conservation Corps (www.ccc.ca.gov).
- Explore veterans (www.gibill.va.gov) and military service (www.myfuture.com) education benefits.
